REPORT OF THE C6 MOBILITY MEETING, PLANEGG (GERMANY),

19TH- 22ND OCTOBER 2020

The 6th mobility meeting of the Erasmus+ (KA2) project "Migration Biographies – Europe on the move" was held from the 19th to the 22nd of October 2020 in Planegg, Germany.

Due to the Covid-19 situation the previously planned C6 mobility meeting in Planegg from April 27th to May 1st had been cancelled and this C6 mobility meeting was organized as replacement. Also due to the situation it was a blended mobility, some participants met physically, the others participated virtually.

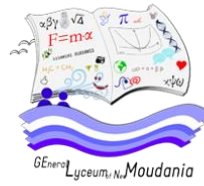
